Day 1	Arrival in Moscow. Transfer from Airport to Hotel. Check in. Free time.
Day 2	<p>Breakfast.</p> <p>Sightseeing tour of Moscow by river-tram (from middle of April till middle of October) (1,5 hours, included in prices) (Kievskiy railway station – Novospassky Bridge).</p> <p>In summer days we suggest you to make river tour in the city of Moscow We start our trip on quay, which is situated next to Kievskaya metro station. Working hours of the quay is daily 11.00- 21.00. River -trams departure each 20 minutes.</p> <p>Passing Kievsky Bridge we are starting in fascinating travel on our city. Arch span structure of Krasnoluzhsky railway bridge built in 1907, was moved in new place at the area of the Kievsky railway station. The main span – two parallel metal crescent two joints farms (span of 135 m, width 10 m) are transported on 2,5 km upstream the river Moscow and on their basis the new foot bridge which not only has connected among themselves large city areas of Plyuschikha and Dorogomilovo is created, but also became one of city-forming sights of Moscow. The glass parabolic arch blocks in the center of a span structure historical riveting arch is a masterpiece of Russian engineering art of beginning XX of a century, creating, thus, unique three nave hall in length of 80 m and width 16 m.</p> <p>Arch elevated transitions through public parts of Berezhkovskaya and Rostov quays come to an end with arch halls. At an underground level there is a complex of technical and office units. Next our look attracts the ensemble of the museum The Novodevichy Convent</p> <p>Novodevichy Convent is the women convent located in a southwest of Moscow, in a bend of Moscow-river. Ensemble of "The Novodevichy Convent is an outstanding monument of architecture of 16-17 centuries. The most remarkable building in the ensemble of the Novodevichy Convent is the Smolensky Cathedral or Cathedral of an icon of the Smolensk Mother of God, constructed simultaneously with the basis of a monastery It is a monumental five-domed temple with paintings of 16 and 17 centuries, with five tier carved iconostasis and rare icons of 17 centuries.</p> <p>Refectory with Uspenija church, belltowers, the churches of a monastery adjoining them Mariinsky and Lopukhinsky palaces - magnificent samples of the Moscow baroque.</p> <p>The monastery has been based by tsar Vasily the 3d in 1524 - in memory of returning in structure of Russian grounds of city of Smolensk. From here is the second name of a monastery. At 16-17 centuries the Novodevichy Convent became a place of taking the veil for women from imperial family. Within the precincts of a monastery there lived the widow of senior son of Ivan the Terrible, tsarevitch Ivan. Here moved after death of Tsar Feodor Ivanovich his widow Irina Godunov with brother Boris Godunov, the future tsar Boris. In the Novodevichy Monastery sister of Peter the 1st, tsarevna Sofia who has violently accepted monastic vows has ended her days. The first wife of Emperor Eudoxia Lopukhin also has been grinded in a monastery.</p> <p>The Novodevichy Convent invariable used protection of Russian autocrats, owned extensive lands. Nuns of a monastery were, as a rule, from the upper layers of the nobility.</p> <p>In 1724 here has been arranged hospital for the soldiers and officers of Russian army and a shelter for foundlings-girls. During the war of 1812 in the Novodevichy Convent there were French armies. At deviation of the Frenchmen the monastery has been prepared for explosion. Only resource of nuns who have appeared in time and was extinguished with fuses, has rescued monastic buildings from destruction. From the end of the 18th century and till 1868 the Novodevichy Convent was used by church authority as corrective establishment for women of Moscow and the Moscow province, condemned of Zemsky court for disbelief. The destiny of the Novodevichy Convent has strongly changed in the beginning of 20th century. In 1922 the monastery has been closed, having arranged here a museum which became branch of the State Historical museum later. Nevertheless, since 1980 in the Novodevichy Convent the residence of metropolitan Krutitsky and Kolomna is placed. And in 1994 the female monastery here has been again founded. Since 1995 in the Smolensk cathedral services on patron saint's days are conducted. In the 16th century in the territory of the Novodevichy Convent the cemetery on which buried representatives of the church and secular nobility has been arranged.</p> <p>In the 19th century in the territory of a monastery heroes of war of 1812 among whom there were a hussar and poet Denis Davidov, Decembrists S.Trubetskoj's and Muraviev-Apostol, and also known art workers, including historian S.Solovev and the philosopher V.Solovev have been buried.</p> <p>The Novodevichy Convent included by UNESCO in the list of the world cultural heritage, is considered one of the oldest and most beautiful monasteries of Russia. On August, 10th, 2004 the Novodevichy Convent celebrated 480 years old.</p> <p>Luzhniki. Luzniki today is one of the largest sports-entertaining complexes of the world. Settling down in a picturesque area of Moscow, it borrows the area exceeding 145 hectares (with access roads and parking places - 180 hectares) and consists of various 140 sports constructions which serve in total more than 3,5 thousand people. The center of an architectural ensemble of "Luzniki" still is the Greater sports arena. From the south and its north there is a swimming pool and small sports arena. Besides the Olympic complex "Luzniki" includes the Palace of sports, a training skating rink "Crystal", the Universal sports hall "Druzhba", Sports small town, the Tennis center, and also Northern and Southern track and field athletics sports kernels, football fields and tennis courts, playgrounds, stadium for shooting from an onions, numerous cafes and restaurants, an office building. Today "Luzniki" is the city of sports and the entertainments, opened for all. In territory of a sport center on a regular basis matches and competitions of the All-Russia and international level are held, and also festivals and concerts of world celebrities. Daily more than thousand people are engaged in educational and improving groups by various kinds of sports, such as: tennis, navigation, scuba diving, volleyball, gymnastics, shaping, figure skating, OFP.</p> <p>The first stop of the steam-ship is Vorobiev Gory. Here opens beautiful view of the Moscow State University. Right and left to the University building there are small parks with the lakes. And in front of the building of the Moscow State University from the river Moscow is located a platform with busts of celebrities. Also nearby there is a viewing platform with a view on stadium Luzniki, it is possible to take a walk below at the river Moscow, or to pass on quay to the Frunzensky Bridge near to which Neskuchny garden is located.</p> <p>The park of Culture meets us with bright green foliage, cheerful shouts and park of attractions. The Krymsky Bridge</p>

	<p>is really beautiful and it is simply impossible to tear off an eye of it.</p> <p>The monument to Peter the 1st settles down directly at the way of the steam-ship. Accurately bending around it at the left, you enjoy magnificent creation in all its beauty.</p> <p>Confectionery factory "Red October" settles down on the right board, it is impossible not to notice it.</p> <p>Temple of the Christ of the Savior is the Cathedral Temple of Russian Orthodox Church in Moscow.</p> <p>Originally constructed under the project of architect Konstantin Ton, in gratitude to the God for rescue of Russia from Napoleonic invasion: « in preservation of eternal memory of that unprecedented diligence, fidelity and love to Belief and Fatherland with what in these hard times has extolled itself Russian people, and in commemoration of our gratitude to Craft of God which has rescued Russia from destruction threatened to it ». The temple is located in the center of Moscow near to the Kremlin on the left bank of the river Moscow, on a place which is earlier called Chortle. The initial building was under construction almost 44 years; it is consecrated on May, 26th, 1883; on December, 5th, 1931 the building of the Temple up to the basis has been destroyed by explosion. The temple has been restored in 1990th years; the Top Temple is consecrated on August, 19th, 2000.</p> <p>The Kremlin is situated in the very centre of Russia's capital. Its powerful walls and towers, golden roofs of temples ancient towers and palaces are mounting on the Borovitsky Hill under river Moscow and compose unrepeatable in its beauty and glory architectural and art ensemble. The Residence of the Russian President is situated today in the Kremlin. Also ensemble of the Moscow Kremlin is included into the UNESCO world cultural and nature heritage and on its territory the State historical-cultural museum "The Moscow Kremlin" is situated. River tour ends by Novospassky Bridge.</p> <p>In the evening: enjoy a ballet or opera performance at the Bolshoy Theatre – one of the world's greatest musical companies (optional).</p>
Day 3	<p>Breakfast.</p> <p>Full day excursion in Yaroslavl.</p> <p>Yaroslavl, one of the oldest cities in Russia, is located on the Volga, 282 km from Moscow. According to the legend, Prince Yaroslav the Wise founded a fortress here in 1010 after he had defeated a huge bear on this spot. The rampant bear is depicted on the coat of arms of the city. Owing to the location at the intersection of important trade routes, Yaroslavl became one of the most important trade centers of Russia. On the territory of the Saviour's Monastery, founded in the 12th century, the oldest building of the city – the Transfiguration Cathedral - is situated. Elia's the Prophet Church was constructed in 1647-1650; its iconostasis is a masterpiece of Russian Baroque style.</p> <p>Yaroslavl is an ancient and at the same time modern city. The destiny of the Russian State reflected in its visage. Yaroslavl has played an essential role in uniting Russian lands around Moscow rendering assistance to Moscow Tsars. One can find many "Yaroslavl pages" in the history of Saint-Petersburg, too.</p> <p>Yaroslavl has its own unique traditions and feeling. That is why the forthcoming 1000-year jubilee the city is celebrating in 2010 can not only provide a powerful impetus for its further development, but also generalize the historic role played by many ancient cities of Russia being forerunners and allies of Moscow.</p> <p>The Russian historiography states that the city could have been founded within rather a long time period: from the year 988 to the year 1024, while most researchers deem the year of 1010, in which the fortress was established, to be most reliable.</p> <p>During its 1000-year history Yaroslavl has been one of the strongholds of the Russian statehood. The rulers of Russia, the Rurikovichs and the Romanovs reigning dynasties, and later the Soviet leaders attached great importance to the city. The very fact of the city foundation was the act of independent political will of the young Prince Yaroslav (the Wise) when he established a fortress on the Volga River to provide security of the northeastern boundaries of ancient Russia. Yaroslavl emerged as the first Christian town on the Volga.</p> <p>During subsequent centuries the city was involved into all dramatic events of the Russian history. Yaroslavl became the first faithful ally of Moscow in bringing the Russian lands together under the patronage of the ancient capital. The Yaroslavl principality was among the first ones to enter the Moscow State voluntarily.</p> <p>In the 15th century after joining the Moscow State, Yaroslavl was assigned an honorary role of "the Sovereign's estate". In the 17th century Moscow Tsars were leaving the city and its districts as percept to their direct heirs.</p> <p>Yaroslavl was the place to transfer the State Treasury in an emergency. People deemed dangerous to the authority were also kept there. Yaroslavl was among the first places influenced by the cruel rule of Ivan IV (the Terrible), but the repressions haven't affected the city itself.</p> <p>In 1612 a volunteer army lead by Kuzma Minin and Dmitry Pozharsky to fight Polish-Lithuanian intervention was being stationed in Yaroslavl, and Yaroslavl was made the capital of Russia for several months.</p> <p>The 18th century was a crucial time for the city. With the erection of Saint-Petersburg the city economy is being re-orientated from commercial to industrial basis. The reign of Peter the Great has radically changed social, political, and economical basis of the ancient capital and also determined the present status of the city as an industrial and cultural centre of Russia. It was in Yaroslavl where Fyodor Volkov founded the first Russian provincial private theatre in 1750. "The Lay of Igor's Host", a remarkable masterpiece of ancient Russian literature, was found in Yaroslavl in the early 90-ies of the 18th century.</p> <p>In the 19th century the city visage was taking its final form. Many art critics call it "Florence of the Russian North" as a variety of architectural schools and styles are merged in Yaroslavl.</p> <p>Significance of the city as a major industrial and cultural centre of Russia is enhancing in the period of modern history. Yaroslavl is holding leading economical positions, as compared to many cities of Central Russia.</p> <p>In the Soviet period the Government assigned the role of the "scientific city" to Yaroslavl. In 20-ies and 30-ies of the last century the foundations were being laid for formation of the new industrial resources of the State orientated towards defense of the country (SC-1, the first synthetic rubber plant in the country, the rubber-asbestos complex, the Yaroslavl automobile plant, etc.).</p> <p>A solid industrial base was being created in Yaroslavl after the end of the Great Patriotic War. The development of the industrial potential of the city was passing under the patronage of the Soviet Government. In the beginning of 1960-ies N. Khrush'ev unofficially visited the city. He expressed a high opinion of the rate of its industrial development. In 1971 the city of Yaroslavl was awarded the Order of the Red Banner of Labour. In 1985, on occasion of its 975-year anniversary, the city was awarded the Order of October Revolution.</p> <p>In the last decade the presidents of Russia visited our city three times. B. Yeltsin attended the opening ceremony of the monument to Yaroslav the Wise. President V. Putin visited Yaroslavl twice: he attended the 250-year jubilee of the Volkov Theatre and the visiting session of the State Council Presidium on motor roads development (October, 2006).</p> <p>Duration: From 08:00 till 22:00-23:00 (is not included in prices)</p>

Day 4	<p>Breakfast. Museum and Panorama "Borodino Battle" (1 hour), (is not included in prices) The Patriotic war of 1812 or "Russian Campaign of Napoleon" occupies one of the most significant places in the century-old, dramatic history of Russia. That war became the beginning of the end of the Napoleon Empire; Napoleon's Grand Army was completely destroyed in Russia. Currently, Museum-Panorama "The Borodino Battle" is the only Moscow Museum with exposition telling about the military campaign of 1812. Panorama was opened on August 29, 1912, in Moscow and has become the focal point of the historic-memorial complex in the honor of the victory of the Russian people. Opened in 1995, new exposition of the Museum displays its exhibits in few sections. Besides the panoramic view of Borodino battle the visitors may also examine some more exponents devoted to the prehistory of Patriotic war, the course of the campaign of 1812, as well as the military events of 1813-1814. Panorama "The Borodino Battle" occupies the central place among the museum exponents. The canvas is 115 meters long and 15 meters high. The painter - F. Rubo - decided to show the decisive moment of the battle - half past twelve of September 7, 1812. The Museum is equipped by modern means, including sound effects, etc. Working hours: from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. Closed: Friday, last Thursday of month.
