The present day Moscow has a European character perfectly joined with the unforgettable features of the Old Russian city. In Moscow, traces of all major events of Russian history are on display and its impact on visitors leaves no one indifferent. We invite you to visit this world-class city of unique historical heritage and amazingly young spirit. As with all tourists, it will leave a great impression on you.

Day 2	<p>Breakfast.</p> <p><b>Sightseeing tour of Moscow (4 hours, included in prices)</b> A city tour is an excellent way to get a good idea about the city. It will take you to the most remarkable sights of the Russian capital with photo stops at the best picture taking points including:</p> <p><b>Red Square:</b> Red Square in Russian means Krasnaya ploshchad, the word krasnaya meaning "beautiful". Over the centuries the square has served various functions- as a market and as a place of executions and of ceremony, from the defeat of Kazan to the spectacles of military strength of the Soviet May-Day parades;</p> <p><b>St. Basil's the Blessed Cathedral:</b> St Basil's Cathedral was commissioned by Ivan the Terrible to celebrate his capture of the Tatar stronghold of Kazan in 1552. Despite its apparent disorder, there is an underlying symmetry to the cathedral, which has eight domed chapels symbolizing the eight assaults on Kazan, clustered around a central, lofty tent-roofed spire. In 1588 Tsar Fyodor added a ninth chapel on the northeastern side to accommodate the remains of St Basil;</p> <p><b>The Kremlin:</b> The small city in the center of Moscow, the seat of government from 1276 to 1712, and then again from March 1918 to the present day. The Kremlin is still very much the heart of Moscow: as well as being Russia's most famous landmark. The word "kreml" means "citadel" or "fortress». In 1156 Prince Uryi Dolgorukiy laid the foundations of the first wooden fortress on Borovitskiy or Pine Hill, at the confluence of the Moscow and Neglinnaya rivers. This first Kremlin was roughly triangular in shape but occupied only about one-sixth of the present site. The oldest structures here, the walls and churches, date from the 15th and 16th centuries, when prince Ivan III was raising up his "Third Rome";</p> <p><b>Alexander garden:</b> The gardens were laid out in 1819-22, after the Neglinka River, which was channeled into an underground pipe. Just inside the gates is the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier. Further along near the Middle Arsenal Tower are a whimsical arched Grotto that really belongs to a country estate, and an obelisk erected to mark the 300th anniversary of the Romanov dynasty.</p> <p><b>The Cathedral of Christ the Saviour once blown up by the Communist and only recently built anew:</b> The magnificent five-golden-domed Cathedral is the largest church in Russia, the second of its kind. The first, built to commemorate the victory over Napoleon in 1812, was destroyed in 1931. It was officially reopened for the millennium and consecrated as a "glorious symbol" of Russia and Russian Orthodox Christianity;</p> <p><b>Arbat street and the White House of Russian Government:</b> White House of Russia has been the seat of the Executive Power of the Russian Federation since the second putch in October, 1993. From 1975 till 1993 it was the seat of the Presidium of the Supreme Soviet (The Highest Legislative Body). The First President of the Russian Federation Boris Yeltsin moved the Parliament (Russian Duma) to the building next to the Kremlin, which had hosted the State Planning Committee, where the 5-year economic plans were affirmed;</p> <p><b>Novodevichiy (New Maiden) Convent:</b> NOVODEVICHY CONVENT AND CEMETERY is a charming place, rich in the spirit of the past, hidden behind a wall in the twentieth century inner city. The sculptured gravestones of famous Russian artists, writers, and politicians illustrate the country's history;</p> <p><b>Victory Park on Poklonnaya Hill devoted to the victory of the Russian arms over the Nazi Germany:</b> VICTORY PARK contains memorials to two Patriotic Wars: in 1812 and 1941-5. In 1983 the Politburo gave its approval to a design by Nikolai Tomskiy that involved leveling the Poklonnaya gora (Heel of greetings). The park itself is laid out around a grand fountain-lined axis culminating in the Central Museum of the Great Patriotic War. The museum displays the Banner of Victory and dioramas showing the main battles in Moscow and Stalingrad, and the blockade of Leningrad. Exhibits show military techniques. A new chapel, Mosque and Synagogue have been built the trio expresses an ecumenical dedication to peace;</p> <p><b>The observation platform on the Sparrow Hills with a breathtaking view on Moscow from this most elevated point of the city:</b> You will have a chance to see this architectural masterpiece, Russia's leading educational institution. One of the oldest Russian institutions of higher education, Moscow University was established in 1755. In 1940 it was named after Academician Mikhail Lomonosov (1711 - 1765), an outstanding Russian scientist, who greatly contributed to the establishment of the university in Moscow.</p> <p>Mikhail Lomonosov was one of the intellectual titans of XVIII century. The Great Russian poet Alexander Pushkin described him as a person of formidable willpower and keen scientific mind, whose lifelong passion was learning. Lomonosov's interests ranged from history, rhetoric, art and poetry to mechanics, chemistry, mineralogy. His activity is a manifestation of the enormous potential of the Russian scientific community whose representatives occupied the leading positions in the world at the time. Peter I reformed Russia, which allowed the country reach the standard of the contemporary European powers in many spheres. Great importance was placed on education. In 1724 the St. Petersburg Academy of Sciences, founded by Peter I, established a university and a grammar school to educate intellectuals and researchers the country needed; however, these educational establishments did not fulfill the task they took on. It was Michail Lomonosov who suggested, in his letter to Count Shuvalov, the idea of establishing a university in Moscow. An influential courtier and the favourite of Empress Elizaveta Petrovna, Count Shuvalov was the patron of the arts and science; he supported Lomonosov's plans for a new university and presented them to the Empress.</p> <p>In 1755, on 25 January, St. Tatiana's Day according to the Russian Orthodox Church calendar, Empress Elizaveta Petrovna signed the decree that a university should be founded in Moscow. The opening ceremony took place on 26 April, when Elizaveta Petrovna's coronation day was celebrated. Since 1755 25 January and 26 April are marked by</p>

	<p>special events and festivities at Moscow University; the annual conference where students present the results of their research work is traditionally held in April.</p> <p><b>Borodino Panorama:</b> Museum, commemorating the decisive battle in 1812, when Napoleon's army was stopped and turned back by the Russian army within sight of the burning city. The museum-panorama is devoted to the brightest episode of the war - the battle near the Borodino village, which Napoleon called "the battle of giants".</p> <p><b>The Kutuzovsky Avenue:</b> The Triumphal Arch was designed by Osip Bove and replaced a wooden arch which had been erected in 1814 for the ceremonial reception of the victorious Russian army. The arch is embellished with statues of Russian soldiers, allegorical figures of Victory and Glory, high reliefs "Expulsion of French intruders" and "Liberation of Moscow".</p>
Day 3	<p>Breakfast.</p> <p><b>Excursion to the Moscow Kremlin and Kremlin Cathedrals. (is not included in prices)</b> The Moscow Kremlin is the centre of the Russian State, a former residence of Russian Tsars. The Russian historian Nicolay Karamzin said: "the Kremlin is a place of great historical recollections". No doubt the Kremlin and Red Square are the most important sights and at the same time symbols of the whole Russia. Since 1992 the Kremlin has been housing the residence of the president of the Russian Federation; that is why tourists can visit only the part of the Kremlin grounds on which cathedrals, the Armory Chamber (the oldest museum of Russia) as well as the so-called Diamond Fund, a unique collection of precious stones and jewelers, are situated. Day 4	<p>Breakfast.</p> <p><b>Tour of the Moscow Metro system and the Old Arbat street. ((is not included in prices)</b> The Moscow Metro is one of the largest and most grandly built metro systems in the world. It was meant to be a showcase of the Soviet Union's achievements both for the Russians themselves and visitors from abroad. The stations are all uniquely designed with decorative elements including mosaics, statues, marble floors, walls and staircases to name a few. The tour will then proceed to Old Arbat street. You will be told of the street's interesting history and view the street's artisan culture. You will also have the opportunity to view and purchase souvenirs from the street are many craftsman. Lunch in a local restaurant (optional).</p> <p><b>Tour of the Tretyakovsky State Gallery. (is not included in prices)</b> The world famous gallery contains works of Russian art from the 10<sup>th</sup> century up until present day. You will view exquisite Russian icons and paintings from the 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> century including works by Rublev, Karavak, Visnyakov, Nikitin, Antropov, Levitsky, Kiprensky, Tropinin, Fedotov, Repin and many others.</p>

- **For tour to the State Tretyakov Gallery:**

It is a world known museum that stores thousands of works of art from ancient Russian icons to modern paintings. Pavel Mikhailovich Tretyakov, the founder of the gallery, started to collect the best works by Russian artists in 1856 and continued to do it for 40 years till his death. At the beginning of the 80s of the 19th century he ordered that a building for the art collection should be constructed in Lavrushinsky Lane. Only after the death of Pavel Mikhailovich the building of the gallery was enlarged to the sketches by the famous Russian artist Viktor Vasnetsov and redecorated in the style correspondent with its purpose. The current exposition comprises the ancient Russian icons of the 12th to 17th centuries as well as paintings, drawings & sculptures of the 18th to 19th centuries along with the Russian avant-garde school among the items.

Then you will see famous Vachtangov Theater and Pushkin's apartment, where he and his wife spent their honeymoon.
