We invite you to visit Moscow and St. Petersburg - the two most beautiful cities of Russia. Both cities are renowned for their numerous museums and galleries, theatres and cathedrals, palaces and parks. The unique historical heritage of these fascinating Russian capitals will make a lasting impression on you and your family.

Day 1	Arrival in Moscow. Transfer from Airport to Hotel. Check in. Free time
Day 2	<p>Breakfast.</p> <p>Excursion to the State Armory Chamber (1, 5 hours), (included in price) The State Armory Chamber is one of the oldest museums in Russia. The building of the Armory Chamber was constructed in 1851 by the architect K.A.Ton especially to house the museum with its world famous collection of jewels. The first mention of the Armory Chamber of the Moscow Kremlin was in 1508. The museum possesses a supremely rich collection of masterpieces of home and foreign, decorative and applied art of the period from the 4th to the beginning of the 20th century. The bulk of the collection is made up of objects of noble metals, armor and arms. Marvelous works by Russian goldsmiths and silversmiths of the 12th to the beginning of the 20th century: dippers, the priceless regalia of the tsar's power and objects that belonged to the tsar court ceremonial from the 13th to 18th centuries are displayed in two rooms of the Armory Chamber. The Armory Chamber is an encyclopedia of the Russian history; each exhibit is a genuine art monument. Working hours: from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Closed: Thursday Address: Kremlin, Museums of the Kremlin Free time in centre of town.</p>
Day 3	<p>Breakfast.</p> <p>We suggest you to visit the museum of wooden architecture first in Russia open-air - Kolomenskoe Estate (territory and Peter's house (3 hours), (optional): Kolomenskoe Estate - the former summer residence of Moscow Grand Princes and Russian Tsars created in the XIV-XVII centuries. It is the unique art, historical, architectural and nature-landscape museum-reserve. Nowadays it is a remarkable place to enjoy Russian folklore performances. At various times in Kolomenskoye brought monuments of wooden architecture XVII-XVIII centuries which placed basically in an ancient Voznesensky garden. Here nearby there were wooden structures from different regions of Russia: Sacred gate of Nikolo-Korelskogo Monastery of 1693 from coast of the White sea, the Brotherly tower of the middle of XVII century from a zone of Brotherly HYDROELECTRIC POWER STATION, Peter's memorial small house of 1 1702 from Arkhangelsk. During excursion you can see the unique complex consisting of 17 monuments of architecture: 12 from them - the saved part of an architectural ensemble of imperial manor XVI-XIX centuries; 4 monuments - the wooden constructions brought from different regions of Russia. In the evening; enjoy a ballet or opera performance at the Bolshoi Theatre – one of the world's greatest musical companies (optional).</p>
Day 4	<p>Breakfast. Check out.</p> <p>Excursion to the Pushkin State Museum of Fine Arts (2 hours) (optional): The museum is situated in the premises of the former Museum of Fine Arts in the old Moscow street Volkhonka. The building of the museum was constructed to the design by the architect R.Klain in 1898-1912. The museum is named after the greatest Russian poet and writer Pushkin. The museum constantly increases its collection. The collection of the museum numbers about 5000 paintings, 35000 drawings and engravings, as well as 100000 coins and medals. The exposition of the museum offers an opportunity to get acquainted with the development of the world art from prehistoric period till the present. Working hours: from 10 a.m. to 7 p.m. Closed: Monday Address: 12, Volkhonka street Transfer to RW Station. Departure from Moscow to St. Petersburg.</p>
Day 5	<p>Arrival in St. Petersburg. Transfer to the hotel. Free time.</p> <p>In the evening boat cruise along the Neva River or canals (optional).</p>
Day 6	<p>Breakfast.</p> <p>Peterhof (6 hours), (optional): The palace-and-park ensemble of Peterhof is a historical and architectural monument of 18-19 centuries. A summer residence of Peter the Great, Peterhof Complex with its palaces, parks and fountains, meant to be a symbol of victory of the Russians over the Swedes, is perhaps the most famous suburb of Saint-Petersburg. The construction works started in 1714 and in 1723 the complex was solemnly opened. The appearance and the inner decoration of the palaces (Grand Palace, Monplaisir, Marly, and Hermitage) underwent several changes according to the fashion and to the tastes of the ruling Emperors and Empresses but the layout of the Lower Park remained mostly as it was intended by Peter the Great. Hundreds of fountains, ornamental patterns of parterres, golden statues in the Lower Park and the Upper Garden are real masterpieces that impress everybody who comes there. Besides the Grand Palace with its 300-meter suite of rooms created by the master of Baroque style F.B .Rastrelli, there are 20 museums with permanent and temporary exhibitions in Peterhof Complex (Special Treasury, Catherine's Block, Cottage, Bath Block, etc). The Grand Palace Museum and Special Storeroom are open from 10.30a.m. till 5p.m. (closed on Monday and last Tuesday of every month) The Cottage Museum is open from 10.30a.m. till 5p.m. (closed on Monday) Monplaisir Museum is open from 10.30a.m. till 5p.m. (closed on Wednesday) Catherine's Block is open from 10.30a.m. till 5p.m. (closed on Thursday). In the evening, enjoy a ballet or opera performance at the Hermitage Theatre: The Hermitage Theatre is a part of the Hermitage Complex. The noble former tsars' court theatre was founded by Catherine the Great in 1785. The entire European repertoire was performed here. After the death of Catherine II in 1796, the theatre was closed. All the attempts to revive the theatre were unsuccessful. Only in 1989, after repair and</p>

	restoration, the theatre was opened again. The theatre has its own orchestra. The orchestra tours abroad for the most part of the year. That is why concerts of classical music are quite rare here. On the stage of the theatre classical ballet and operas are performed.
Day 7	<p>Breakfast. Free day.</p> <p>Night city tour (White Nights in summer time) (2,5 hours) (optional).</p> <p>During the city sightseeing tour you will see the most beautiful sights of the former Imperial capital of Russia. The golden spire of the Admiralty is one of the symbols of St. Petersburg and a compositional centre of the central part of the city. Three streets like a trident of Neptune come from the tower of the Admiralty, among which is the city's main street - Nevsky Prospect, a street of expensive shops and hotels, restaurants and cinemas. A lot of churches of different confessions are located on this street. The most remarkable ones of which are the ancient-looking Kazan Cathedral and the picturesque Church of Resurrection or Saviour the Spilt Blood Church, owing its second name to the cruel fact in the Russian history -the murder of the Russian Tsar Alexander II who was assassinated at this spot. Not far from the Admiralty there is the main square of the city - the Palace Square. This architectural ensemble includes a majestic Empire style building of General Staff, the Alexander Column, the monument glorifying the Russian Emperor Alexander I, the winner of the war of 1812 against Napoleon, and the former residence of the Russian Tsars - Winter Palace, magnificent building of the Russian baroque style. Now the halls of the palace contain the works of art of the collection of the biggest museum of Russia - the Hermitage.</p> <p>From the Palace square one can see the golden dome of St Isaac's Cathedral, one of the biggest large-domed cathedrals in the world. From the viewing platform of the upper colonnade of the cathedral one can admire a splendid panorama of the city. At the other side of the cathedral near the Neva river there is one more city's landmark- an equestrian statue to its founder Peter the Great, better known as the Bronze Horseman.</p> <p>The Point of Vasilievsky Island is the favorite place of the locals and guests of the city. Here one can have a magnificent view of the city and the city's oldest construction - the Peter and Paul Fortress. The highest building of the fortress is the Cathedral of St. Peter and Paul with its golden spire dominating over the flat banks of the city's low-lying islands. It also is the last resting place of the Russian Tsars of the Romanov dynasty.</p> <p>Close to the Peter and Paul Fortress in the Bigger Nevka river there is another object of note attracting the guests of the city - Aurora Battleship, famous for being a symbol of the October Revolution of 1917, as the blank shot fired from Aurora on 25th of October was a signal to start the storm of the Winter Palace. At all the remarkable sights of the city the tourists usually have photo stops during the sightseeing tour which generally lasts for 4 hours.</p> <p>One can refer to the city's unique things a phenomenon of White Nights, the period that lasts from late May to the mid-July during which it never gets dark at night. City tour by one of such nights will give an opportunity to enjoy the city's beautiful sights, bring a great pleasure and unforgettable memories!</p>

The Metropol Hotel is located in the very centre of Moscow opposite the Bolshoy Theatre and within three minutes' walking distance from Red Square and the Kremlin.

The Metropol Hotel was opened in 1901. The hotel owes its birth to the famous patron of art Savva Mamontov. To build a hotel of the European level he gathered young talented artists and architects: W.Walcott, M.Vrubel, L.Kekushev. They were working with the new style of architecture - Art Nouveau. The wall panel **the Faraway Princess** by M.Vrubel is the main decoration of the Metropol facade. Since its opening the Metropol Hotel has been recognized as Russia's most renowned grand hotel and a favorite place of cosmopolitan society - from the royalty and the aristocracy to famous personalities in arts and international affairs. Leo Tolstoy, Fyodor Shalyapin were among the guests of the hotel. In 1917, after the socialist revolution, the Metropol Hotel turned into the residence of the All-Russian Central Executive Committee (RCEC). It was then called the Second House of Soviets. Lenin, Stalin and other Bolshevik leaders lived and worked here. In the 1930s the Metropol was given back its original status of a top-class hotel. If the Soviet government wished to win the favor of the foreign guests (among them were Bernard Shaw, Bertolt Brecht, John Steinbek, Marlen Dietrich), it would usually accommodate them in the Metropol. In 1986 the hotel was closed for a major refurbishment, which was undertaken so that the hotel could again offer its guests the most advanced facilities in an atmosphere of elegance and luxury of the bygone age. In the past years such prominent persons as members of royal families of Spain, Netherlands, Denmark, Pierre Cardin, the great courtier, and renowned actors Pierre Richard, Anny Girardot, and Sharon Stone stayed at the Metropol Hotel during their visits to Moscow.

The Metropol offers a wide range of services to ensure a comfortable stay, a productive environment for business, and also a chance for rest and relaxation. These include various restaurants, a night club and a casino, a beauty parlour, a gift shop. The hotel's newsstand enables guests to keep pace with world affairs. Guests can also use the booking service for air and railway tickets, and a car rental facility. The concierge service provides guests with comprehensive information about business and cultural

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life of Moscow. The hotel's health club offers extensive facilities for exercise and relaxation. The club includes an indoor pool, a sauna and a gym. The trained and licensed staff provides massage and training seven days a week.

The Metropol restaurant is one of the most popular restaurants in Moscow. Its glass ceiling creates a stunning setting that is rich in warmth and historical splendor. The restaurant serves Russian and European cuisines.

The Evropeisky restaurant is favored by those who love coziness and calm atmosphere. The hall interior is designed in neo-classical style and decorated with columns and mirrors. The restaurant menu includes dishes of Russian and European cuisines.

The Boyarsky restaurant is located on the 4th floor of the hotel and offers the old Russian cuisine. It is considered an evening deluxe restaurant. The Boyarsky restaurant is an example of old palace architecture as its interior is designed in the style of boyar chambers.

Also at guests' service are the cafe-confectionery and the Shalyapin lobby bar.

Throughout its history the Metropol has been the venue for many grand occasions. Today the hotel's banqueting team upholds this fine tradition. The Metropol's 10 elegantly designed banquet and conference rooms suit to a wide range of events from large conferences and banquets to private parties.
